Turkish Group of the Marcé Society A Meeting, 'Louis Victor Marcé and Perinatal Psychiatry' was held at Istanbul, Turkey by Turkish Marcé Society

Since Prof. Mazhar Osman, the most popular pioneer of Turkish Psychiatry, founded Bakirkoy Research and Training Hospital for Psychiatry, Neurology and Neurosurgery in 1924, many women with psychiatric disorders have been treated in this hospital, including perinatal ones. Nowadays, psychiatrists are paying more attention to the topic of perinatal psychiatry in every part of Turkey, where the rate of pregnancy is the highest in Europe. The professionals look for what has been done before, undertake researches to highlight previous knowledge.


