## A Message to Participants

You may be wondering whether we are still having the 2020 Marcé conference in light of the pandemic. As of today (April 7), the conference is six months away. I, in consultation with our Executive Board and the University of Iowa Center for Conferences, recognize that the trajectory of this pandemic is uncertain. We will continue to evaluate travel restrictions/recommendations and keep you informed of all decisions about the conference on the conference website, https://marce2020.com/. In the spirit of the message from Queen Elizabeth, in a rare public address, "We should take comfort that while we may have more still to endure, better days will return...we will meet again." And we hope it will be in Iowa City in October.

On a positive note, we are pleased that there were over 450 submitted abstracts!
